Liechtensteinklamm

The roaring waterfalls and rushing water have carved over millennia deeper and deeper into the canyon. The rocks are now in some places so narrow and high, that the sky, in some parts, is only can be seen as small strips.

Already in 1875 the people was fascinated by this natural spectacle. So much that the gorge was made available for the general public with bridges and footbridges through a donation from the Prince of Liechtenstein, therefore also the name. The duration of the trip is about 2–3 hours and you can easily reach the gorge in 30 minutes on foot from the hotel.

Nationalpark Hohe Tauern

The National Park “Hohe Tauern” is the largest protected area in the Alps. Wild primeval landscape and landscape cultivated by mountain farmers. These are the two faces of the Hohe Tauern National Park. With 1.834 km² it is by far the largest nature reserve in the Alps. The protected area extends over vast alpine primeval landscapes such as glaciers, rock faces and turf, as well as over the centuries carefully and painstakingly cultivated alpine pastures. The Hohe Tauern National Park was established in 1981, making it Austria’s first National Park. During the following years, the reserve on which the three federal states of Carinthia, Salzburg and Tyrol are involved, became the largest protected natural area in the Alps. The journey time is about 35 minutes.

Berghof’s Tip: You go partially over boulders. Hike only at good weather.

If you just want to have a beautiful view over the mountains comfortably from the water, a panoramic tour on the Lake in Zell am See is just right for you.


Or do you want a whole ship itself - then charter one of our four ships for a party on the water. 45 minutes on the high seas and in 45 minutes you are in Zell am See.

Grossglockner High Alpine Road

The most famous alpine road leads you into the heart of the National Park Hohe Tauern, Austria's highest mountain, the Grossglockner (3,798 m) and its glacier, the Pasterze. At 48 km high alpine road, at a height rising to 2,504 meters you will find a driving and nature experience of a special kind! For this, you should allow a whole day! The journey time to Bruck / a d Glockernstraße is approximately 40 minutes.

A little tip: Find out in case of bad weather if the road is open.

Mozarts city – Salzburg

Tourist information:

If you take the bus into the city, get off at the station "Mozartsteg", cross the street and walk over the bridge. Then you just walk straight ahead. Continue to the Mozart Square. On the Mozartplatz Nr. 5 is a tourist information center. Here you will get all the important information and maps.

Kitzsteinhorn

If there is yet tender sprouts in the valley green, the Kitzsteinhorn still glitters in brilliant white. The charming 3000 world offers both sunbathers and walkers as well as winter sports a lot.

Take a day time visit the natural wonders around 40 minutes away by car. First, the Glacier cable car takes you up to 2,452 m to the Alpine Center. From there you take the cable car to 3,029 m to the panoramic restaurant. Further you go through a tunnel to reach a viewing platform, from which you have a breathtaking view of the panorama of 3000.

Recommended are solid boots and waterproof clothing.

Fortress Hohenwerfen

High above the Salzach Valley, between the Tennen and Hagen mountains, sits the 900 year old fortress "Hohen Werfen", a former fortress from the 11th century. The castle tours provide a lot from weapons exhibition, a romantic castle tavern, a medieval shop and the historic falconry with daily flight demonstrations to the first Austrian Provincial Falk Museum with regularly changing special exhibitions.

The tour lasts about 1 hour

The salt mines of Salzburg

The unique journey into the depths of the salt mine at Bad Dürrnberg begins with the issue of the traditional mountain man costume. All in white, you go with a small train through the tunnels of the mine. Down smoothly polished slides you go from one to another level to reach the heart of the mountain.

Always with you is your miner who introduces you very vividly the underground world. With a raft you slide through the famous salt lake surrounded by mystical sounds. Fast-paced rides on the mine train, two miners' slides with speed measurement and a raft ride across the subterranean salt lake.

Children may not visit the salt mine until the age of 4! Prepare warm clothes and sturdy shoes.

Salzburger Eisriesenwelt

The, until today, largest discovered ice cave in the world is a spectacular natural phenomenon and one of the most daunting cave systems in general. The beauty of the ice sculptures and the impressive scale of the cave compensate to be overcome 134 m during the visit! The implementation rate is matched to the particular visitor structure. At the cave entrance, visitors are equipped with miner's lamps. Inside magnesium light provides effective lighting of the ice sculptures. The cave itself is a protected monument and can be entered only with authorized guides.

Duration of tour: The tour lasts about 1 hour and 15 minutes. To visit, you should plan approximately 3 to 4 hours.

Preparation: Recommended are sturdy shoes and warm clothing. The temperature in summer is usually below zero. Strong mobility problems or cardiovascular patients are discouraged people from a cave visit.

Adventure cave – Entrische Kirche

It is not only the size of the halls, which makes it an experience to visit this cave, you will encounter wonderful stalactites and limestone formations.

The cave name "Hidden Church" (eerie cave) was first mentioned in 1428. On the occasion of the 500th anniversary of Martin Luther in 1983 Richard Erlmoser erected a Protestant memorial in the "bat Dom" of the cave. The cave is unique in its kind and is also a special "place of power".

Many visitors feel the positive earth radiation. The tour lasts about 50 minutes. Walking from the parking lots in Klammstein takes about 35 minutes. Follow local instructions.

Open air museum Salzburg

In the Salzburger Open-Air Museum are obtained representative or typical examples of rural construction and home decor for posterity.

You get the impression that they had always had their home in the museum at the foot of the mountain the 60 buildings. Forests, meadows with the corresponding fence forms, chapels and shrines, fruit trees and grain fields are involved in the representation of buildings. Take a day-time for this trip.

Tip: The various events are highly recommended. Possibly connect this visit with a trip to the Unterberg (by cable car).

Nature museum

With approximately 250,000–300,000 visitors annually, the Nature Museum is one of the biggest attractions of the city of Salzburg. Especially families, but also experts find modern, museum didactic and aesthetically groundbreaking exhibitions, events and programs in all areas of nature.

The House of Nature includes the areas of the aquarium, reptiles, marine habitats, dinosaurs, space, human, evolution, insects, Africa, Desert, Ice Age, plate tectonics and much more. Connected to the city of Salzburg, it is a full day trip. The tour lasts about 1 hour.

Tip: At the Aquarium of the house of nature are regular feedings of piranhas, sharks and protected fish and octopus.

Zoo Hellbrunn/Salzburg

The unique zoo landscape at Hellbrunner mountain with a steep rock wall on one side and the foothills in the rich pastures on the other side is home to about 800 wild animals in the Zoo Salzburg.

Domestic and exotic animals – from alpine ibex to the mongoose – all live on the approximately 14-acre zoo grounds in natural, spacious facilities.

To visit, you should plan at least half a day.

Wild life- & amusement park Ferleiten

Right on the Grossglockner road, before the toll station, you will find more than 200 native to the Alps animals on approximately 15 acres.

The walk through the park takes about an hour. The trails are suitable for pushchairs and wheelchairs. Set within the grounds there is a large pond with plenty of seating and picnic facilities and a lookout tower. Teaching and display boards provide information about the flora and fauna of the Alps.

In about 40 minutes you have already arrived in Ferleiten. Experience fun and games to 20,000 m² surrounded by spectacular mountain scenery. For Catered in our dwarfs pub and buffalo bar!

Canyoning

A "must" for people who prefer to look beyond instead of only into a ravine - a perspective change which is worth it! Well packed in warm wetsuit "hiking" (swimming, climbing, jumping, abseiling, sliding) between spectacular rock formations and towering rock walls. Numerous cracks or rappelling from different heights is just one attraction of these tours.

Canyon Classic: The classic, numerous jumps from 2 to 10 m, many swim throughs, slides, the tour is not too heavy and provides a lot of fun. Total duration about 3,5 - 4,5 hours.

Canyon Intensive: Day tour in incredibly beautiful scenery, a bit more challenging (experience required), many jumps of 4 -16 m (also descendible with rope), swim throughs. Total duration about 5-7 hours.
